Version 1



As if by magic,

A procession of five birds appears: A solitary Dodo, two chattering Geese, and two Vultures acting as security guards, accompanied by a prestigious flying Puffin.

While playfully interacting with the audience, this small squadron moves closer to the ultimate prize, the coveted giant gift box, circling around it with joyful curiosity.

he gift box opens, revealing a giant, colorful Flower.

Our flock of birds is overjoyed; they whirl around the Flower, sending festive wishes to the entire crowd.







Version 2



Seven extravagant birds come to play with the audience:

A Dodo, two Geese, two Vultures, an Ibis, and a Bird of Paradise.

hey discover a lush green hill.

Suddenly, the hill trembles, as if shaken by an earthquake.

It turns out to be the back of a creature with a plant-like coat,
the Hippoguanodon, inspired by Winsor McCay's Little Nemo comic strip.

This young and spirited creature plays with the birds and then with the audience.

The small company resumes its journey.

The Hippoguanodon, accompanied by the birds, eagerly approaches, full of curiosity.

The gift box opens, revealing a magnificent puffin that takes flight.

Everyone joins in the celebration, playing with the audience and inviting them to dance.



Version 3



ine whimsical birds delight the audience:

A Dodo, two Geese, two Vultures, an Ibis, two Birds of Paradise, and a Rooster.





After fluttering about among the crowd,

our lively flock discovers a green crest that suddenly starts to quiver.

It is none other than the back of the Hippoguanodon, emerging both from Little Nemo and from its nap.

Young, curious, and full of energy, it is eager to play.

And so, our magical caravan

sets off once more in search of new adventures.





two enormous raspberries block the path.


The Hippoguanodon is a gourmet and particularly fond of raspberries.

The gift box opens, revealing a magnificent puffin that takes flight.



Nature of the Show

- Daylight or nigh Parade
- Duration : TDB
- Casting: Please see artistic file.

General Conditions

- Maximum wind tolerated: 25km/h
- Possible weather day, to be discussed prior to contract.

Performance Area

- Show area must be as flat as possible. No big obstacle on ground.
- No wires or air obstacle on the entire show area.
- If streets: No traffic allowed.
- Inflation area close to show area with same features and NO audience.

Technical Summary

This summary document serves as your budget forecast and must be supplemented by a full technical specification sheet: a document available upon request.

Only the final technical specification sheet, produced after the survey, will be binding.

Setup the day of show

- 5H Setup including inflation, Load out 3h.
- Packing and ATA process 4h the day after.
- TEAM : upon option (see below)
- FREIGHT: TBD

Technical requirements

- Helium forecast : quantity opon option, please see below. Storage, onsite delivery, logistics for organizer.
- Secured dressing room 3m² by team member. 2 electric supply 16A 240V, 24h/24, close to catering and sanitaries facilities.
- Dry sand for our bags (we come with empty bags), quantity upon option, see below.
- Électric Supply: 16A 240V on inflation area.
- Sound system adapted to area AND audience capacity: moving or not... Please note that Plasticiens Volants can provide songs but no PA.
- LIGHT: If night Parade, please note that Plasticiens Volants does not have lights on inflatables. This is at contractor's discretion to setup lights on parade route.

 However we can provide hand led lights on batteries that can be carried by volunteers.

 To be defined prior to contract.
- Inflation zone outside the performance area, to be determined during the site visit.

Human ressources

- Roadies for setup, show and loadout. 1 day.
- Helpers: adult volonteers to help us inflate and evolve in audience area (see below)
- Local participants : local amateur performers.
- Security: permanent guarding of all premises from the start of assembly to the end of dismantling. Including dressing rooms, storage, inflation areas, technical areas.
